COLLECT

O God of eternal glory, you anointed Jesus your servant to bear our sins, to encourage the weary, to raise up and restore the fallen. Keep

before our eyes the splendour of the paschal mystery of Christ, and, by our sharing in the passion and resurrection, seal our lives with the victorious sign of his obedience and exaltation. We ask this through Christ, our liberator from sin, who lives with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, holy and mighty God for ever and ever.

POST COMMUNION

Lord Jesus Christ, you humbled yourself in taking the form of a servant, and in obedience died on the cross for our salvation: give us the mind to follow you and to proclaim you as Lord and King, to the glory of God the Father.

We explore celebrating as a gathered community: Holy Spirit, we pray for those across the world gathering to praise you. In places where people risk their lives to worship together: may they know your presence. For those who are finding things hard or who have been hurt by others: may they know your presencé.

Annual Elections for laity representatives to the **Deanery Synod and Parochial Church Council**

The Annual Parish Meeting will be held on Sunday, 16th April 2023 and Members of the Electoral Roll are warmly encouraged to stand for election to the PCC (Parish Church Council). A balance of skills and experience is sought where possible with nominees being willing to take an active interest in different aspects of church life and administration. As a Member of the PCC you become a Charitable Trustee, the Parish having been registered as an independent charity with the Charity Commission in 2009. It is governed under the powers of the Parochial Church Council (Powers)

Measure (1956) as amended and the Church Representation Rules as amended. We are looking for 4 nominations this year, 10 being the maximum number. PCC members serve a three year term and can re-stand for a further three years.

The four Deanery Synod representatives stand for three years and are re-elected this year. There are 3 meetings a year held in different parishes within the Rotherfield Deanery. We are looking for 1 nomination. Deanery Synod representatives also attend PCC Meetings.

Nomination forms are at the back of the Church and Electoral Roll members can propose and second applications. Please hand in completed forms to the Churchwardens or PCC Secretary, Emma Ryder Richardson.
