COLLECT

Almighty God, You show to those who are in error the light of your truth, That they may return to the way of righteousness: Grant to all those who are admitted into the fellowship of Christ's religion, That they may reject those things that are contrary to their profession,

And follow all such things as are agreeable to the same; Through our Lord Jesus Christ, Who is alive and reigns with you, In the unity of the Holy Spirit, One God, now and for ever.

PAUSE FOR THOUGHT

In today's Gospel, Jesus' followers are receiving honest, unwelcome news. He isn't the Messiah they've been expecting....victorious over their enemies, triumphant and all-powerful; he won't pander to their misguided longings. Gently but firmly he outlines the Messiah's role, clearly

explained in the scriptures (e.g. Isaiah 53) but overwritten by popular dreams of defeating Roman oppression. Peter tries to shut it out; he can't bear to hear it. Maybe sometimes Jesus nudges us to change some wrong thinking in our lives and we don't want to hear it.
