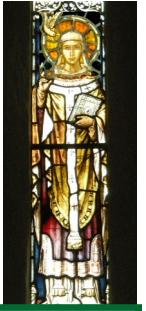

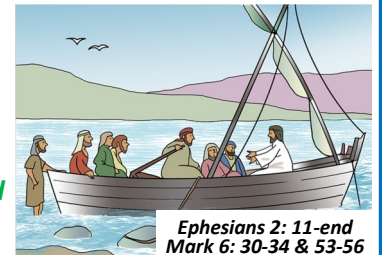
Dear God,
