



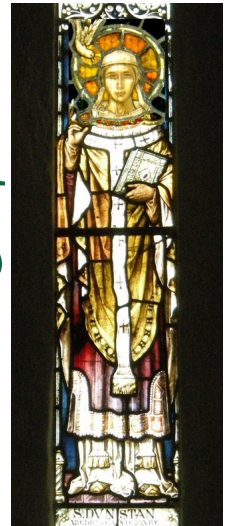

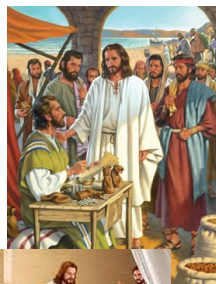


Sunday Club
