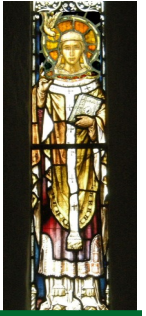

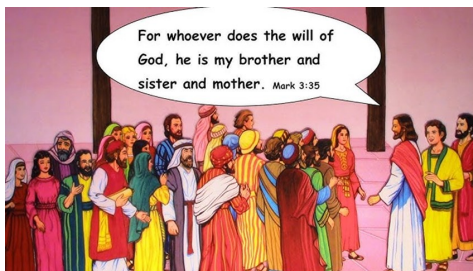
Meet in London House from 10am.

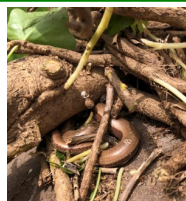
