Of course, red is the colour of fire, the colour of the flames descending

on the apostles in our New Testament reading, heralding the coming of The Holy Spirit, mysterious, elemental, beyond human control and understanding; promised by Jesus, in our Gospel reading (John15:26). This 'Advocate' is there to help us all; we share what comes from the 'Spirit of truth' with the apostles and with all Christians who listen to His voice.


