To summarise: still no congregational singing is permitted but 'a group of up to 6 amateur singers can perform, or rehearse for performance, with physical distancing being maintained at all times.' (Para 18). This has caused consternation nationwide and many public bodies are taking the issue up with the Government. We hope clarification and/or amendment will soon be forthcoming but in the meantime, we respectfully ask for your continued understanding.


