



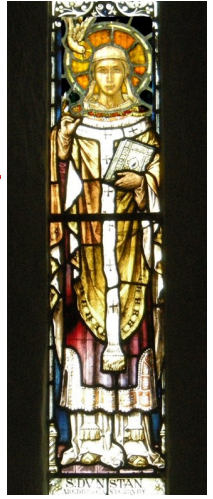

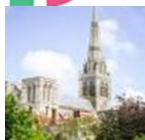
Chichester
