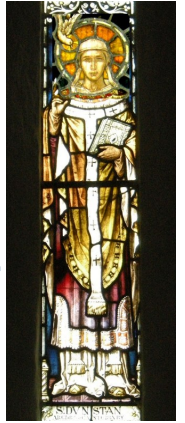

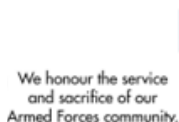
2ND NOVEMBER—ALL SAINTS'

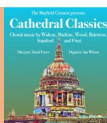
