



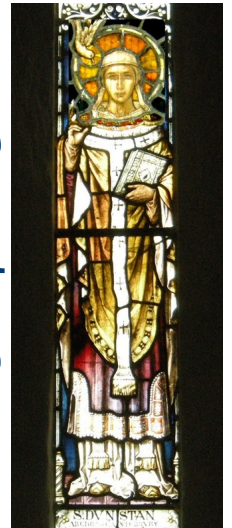

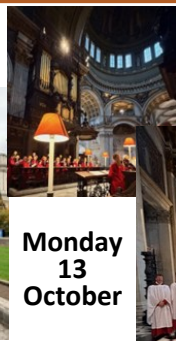
Choral Evensong

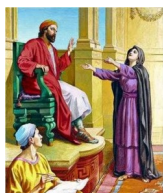


Sunday Club
